program description

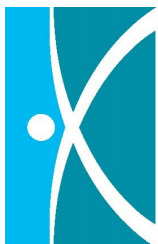
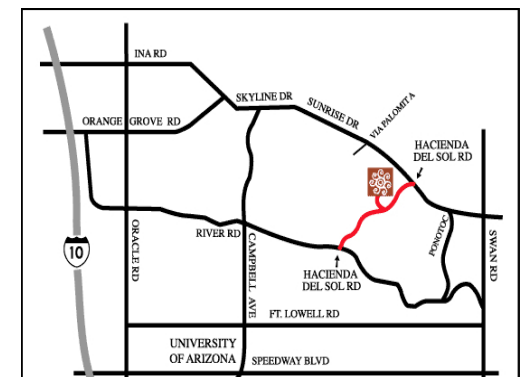
Dr. Dianne Elise, drawing on Kristeva's (2014) conceptualization of maternal eroticism, will explore the "multiverse" of mother/child erotic sensibilities, as well as considering their parallel within the clinical dyad. She offers a formulation of an analytic eroticism, thus expanding the terrain of what might traditionally be viewed as erotic transference and countertransference.

Dr. Elise will emphasize *analytic vitality*, instead of neutrality. She shifts the metaphor of a blank screen—analyst as subdued, almost erased figure—to a more colorful image, moving analytic function from abstinence to sustenance, a quality of aliveness in the analyst that is sustaining, rather than a representation of a deadened mother.
