program description


The center does not hold. The ground gives way, and we are lost and falling. The ancients knew about the sudden overturning of the order of things: “Catastrophe” derives from the Greek, from “down” and “turn over”. We lost the world we took for granted and the familiar turns strange. Here psychoanalytic and existential perspectives illuminate one another. In the morning session, we will explore the transforming of awareness and its everyday grounding in the world along a continuum of the strange from existential authenticity to traumatic dissociation. In particular we will look at Freud’s conception of “deferred action” or “afterwards” and the existential conceptions of the familiar and the strange.

Life is understood backwards, Kierkegaard observed, but must be lived forwards. Continual change of perspective and direction is built into the psychoanalytic way of engagement as analyst and analyst try to find their way. The presentation in the afternoon will explore the arc of one psychoanalysis and a return years later with a throw of life’s dice.

location and directions
